 - Jerry Carter (2000)
 - Jelmer Vernooij (2002)



Recent Advances



- John H Terpstra (2003)
 - Quick update of Samba-HOWTO-Collection (maybe 2 weeks)
 - Outcome was "The Samba-3 HOWTO & Reference Guide"
 - Will be fully in SVN this week
 - That led to "Samba-3 by Example" Released at this conference
 - Also going into the SVN documentation tree this week



Objectives



- Facilitate
 - Deployment
 - Integration into MS Windows networks
 - Replacement of MS Windows servers
 - Expand opportunity for use of Non-Microsoft platforms in exclusively Microsoft environments
- Enrich employment opportunities
 - Samba competency
 - Wider recognition of Samba in Windows network environments



Forward Plans



- Wider promotion of Samba documentation
 - Translation to reach a wider world
 - German
 - About 40% of HOWTO completed
 - French
 - Progress is steady (not sure of completion status)
 - Japanese
 - No recent feedback may have stalled
- LPI Certification
 - Exam development at JTA (job task analysis) point now
