## Requeum for File Storage



- Predictions
  - Desktop is dead
  - Laptop demand is in decline
- Projection that:
  - File storage market is shrinking!
    - Really?
    - Cloud is the future ...

#### What Could Cloud Mean?



- If the bulk of the IT industry moves to the Cloud
  - That is a big IF!
  - But the signs are real
- There will be opportunity to store VM images
  - In File Systems!
  - Using NFS, CIFS, SMB at the back-end
  - Not visible to the consumer
    - but still there in some form
