- DNS

## DNS (replication)

- Reverse DNS
  - dns\_update
- ~~SOA entry for additional DC~~

## Administration tools

- Graphical tool (used to Windows)
  - ▶ Samba-Gtk?
  - ▶ Django frontend for samba-tool?

## Administration tools

- samba-tool
  - ▶ subnet creation/removal
  - ▶ listing

## Group policies

- Linux GPO
  - ▶ Proxy settings (remember bandwidth)
  - ▶ Password settings

# Trusts

- Trust of Windows AD domain
- Multiple domains

## Enumeration speed (member server)

- idmap rid backend
- Large groups

## Bandwidth => WSUS

- Windows Server Update Services
  - ▶ Windows updates 'cache'
- Samba server with WSUS role?
